

Pat, Pip and Puck Pumpkin

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Materials

Pat

Orange Pumpkin

15gr. of 4-ply (fine) cotton yarn in orange I used Yarn and Colors Must-have Sunset 021 Crochet hook 2,5mm (US C/2 UK 12) Black safety eyes 6mm Fiberfill Tapestry needle

Pip

Brow pumpkin

15gr. of 4-ply (fine) cotton yarn in brown I used Yarn and Colors Must-have Satay 026 Crochet hook 2,5mm (US C/2 UK 12) Black safety eyes 6mm Fiberfill Tapestry needle

Puk

White pumpkin

15gr. of 4-ply (fine) cotton yarn in white I used Yarn and Colors Must-have Cream 002 Crochet hook 2,5mm (US C/2 UK 12) Black safety eyes 6mm Fiberfill Tapestry needle

Hat

15gr. of 4-ply (fine) cotton yarn in black I used Yarn and Colors Must-have Black 100 Some left over 4-ply (fine) cotton yarn in beige I used Yarn and Colors Must-have Clay 005 Crochet hook 2,5mm (US C/2 UK 12) Tapestry needle

The finished size of Pat, Pip and Puck is approx. 17cm/6.7inch when using 4-ply yarn and hook UK12 and USC/2

Used abbreviations (US terms)

MR = Magic Ring Sc = Single crochet St = Stitch Ch = Chain HDC = Half Double Crochet FLO = Front Loop Only BLO = Back Loop Only RSC = Reverse Single Crochet (Crab stitch) DEC. = Decrease INC. = Increase

Pat

With Orange Stuff the pumpkin firmly while crocheting

- 1. 6sc in MR (6)
- 2. 6x (Inc.) (12)
- 3. 6x (1sc, inc.) (18)
- 4. 6x (1sc, inc., 1sc) (24)
- 5. 6x (3sc, inc.) (30)
- 6. 6x (2sc, inc., 2sc) (36)
- 7. 6x (5sc, inc.) (42)
- 8. 6x (3sc, inc., 3sc) (48)
- 9.-10. 48sc in each stitch around (48)
- 11. 2x (23sc, inc.) (50)
- 12.-13. 50sc in each stitch around (50)
- 14. 2x (23sc, dec.) (48)
- 15.-16. 48sc in each stitch around (48)
- 17. 6x (3sc, dec., 3sc) (42)
- 18. 6x (5sc, dec.) (36)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 11/12 with 3st between them.

- 19. 6x (2sc, dec., 2sc) (30)
- 20. 6x (3sc, dec.) (24)
- 21. 6x (1sc, dec., 1sc) (18)
- 22. 6x (1sc, dec.) (12)
- 23. 6x (dec.) (6)

Close the ring. Leave a long tale.

Embroider with black a little mouth on the pumpkin.



Shaping the pumpkin

Pull the thread through the pumpkin and pull it tight. Repeat this 5 more times. It will divide the pumpkin into 6 pieces. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Pip

Met brown Stuff the pumpkin firmly while crocheting.

- 1. 6sc in MR (6)
- 2. 6x (inc.) (12)
- 3. 6x (1sc, inc.) (18)
- 4. 6x (1sc, inc., 1sc) (24)
- 5. 6x (3sc, inc.) (30)
- 6. 6x (2sc, inc., 2sc) (36)
- 7. 6x (5sc, inc.) (42)
- 8.-9. 42sc in each stitch around (42)
- 10. 2x (20sc, inc.) (44)
- 11.-12. 44sc in each stitch around (44)
- 13. 2x (20sc, dec.) (42)
- 14.-15. 42sc in each stitch around (42)
- 16. 6x (5sc, dec.) (36)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 10/11 with 3st between them.

- 17. 6x (2sc, dec., 2sc) (30)
- 18. 6x (3sc, dec.) (24)
- 19. 6x (1sc, dec., 1sc) (18)
- 20. 6x (1sc, dec.) (12)
- 21. 6x (dec.) (6)

Close the ring. Leave a long tale.

Embroider with Black a little mouth on the pumpkin.

See Pat for the description of how to shape the pumpkin.



Stem

With beige Don't stuff the stem

- 1. 6sc in MR (6)
- 2.-6. 6sc in each stitch around (6)
- 7. FLO 6x (inc.) (12)
- 8. 6x (1sc, inc.) (18)

Fasten off leaving a long tale to sew the stem on top of Pip.

Fasten off and weave in ends.





Put Pip on top of Pat and sew both pumpkins together. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Puck

With White. Stuff the pumpkin firmly while crocheting.

6sc in MR (6)
 6x (inc.) (12)
 6x (1sc, inc.) (18)
 6x (1sc, inc., 1sc) (24)
 6x (3sc, inc.) (30)
 6x (2sc, inc., 2sc) (36)

7.-8. 36sc in each stitch around (36)

9. 2x (17sc, inc.) (38)

10.-11. 38sc in each stitch around (38)

12. 2x (17sc, dec.) (36)

13.-14. 36sc in each stitch around (36)

15. 6x (2sc, dec., 2sc) (30)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 9/10 with 3st between them.

- 16. 6x (3sc, dec.) (24)
- 17. 6x (1sc, dec., 1sc) (18)
- 18. 6x (1sc, dec.) (12)
- 19. 6x (dec.) (6)

Close the ring. Leave a long tale to shape the pumpkin. See Pat for the description of how to shape the pumpkin.

Put Puck on top of Pip (see photo) and sew them together.

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Hat

With Black. Don't stuff the hat.

> 1. 6sc in MR (6) 2.-4. 6sc in each stitch around (6) 5. 3x (1sc, inc.) (9) 6.-9. 9sc in each stitch around (9) 10. 3x (2sc, inc.) (12) 11.-14. 12sc in each stitch around (12)15. 3x (3sc, inc.) (15) 16.-18. 15sc in each stitch around (15) 19. 3x (4sc, inc.) (18) 20.–21. 18sc in each stitch around (18) 22. 3x (5sc, inc.) (21) 23. 21sc in each stitch around (21) 24. 3x (6sc, inc.) (24) 25. 24sc in each stitch around (24) 26. 3x (7sc, inc.) (27) 27. 27sc in each stitch around (27) 28. 3x (8sc, inc.) (30) 29. 30sc in each stitch around (30) 30. FLO 30sc in each stitch around (30)

31. 6x (2sc, inc., 2sc) (36)







32. 6x (5sc, inc.) (42)
33. 6x (3sc, inc., 3sc) (48)
34. 48RSC in each stitch around (48)
Fasten off and weave in ends.
Turn the tip of the hat slightly (see photo)

Belt

With beige.

Ch32 (or less or more. Make sure it fits the hat), in 3^{rd} ch from the hook 1HDC, 29HDC (30)

Fasten off and leave a long tale to sew the belt together. It will now form a ring.



Put the belt around the hat and secure with a few stitches. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Embroider with black a buckle on the belt.



Sew the hat with a few stitches on top of Puck. Fasten off and weave in ends.





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
